On August 30, 2012 I was dispatched to the Stone Building student parking lot reference a hit and run traffic crash.

Upon my arrival, I made contact with Samantha Tackett who stated the following:

Tackett stated she was waiting in the student parking lot located by the Stone Building when she noticed a Gray pick up truck about to leave a parking spot.

Tackett stated she pulled over to the side and waited for the parking spot. The driver of the pick up truck told Tackett he was holding his spot for his "Bro".

Tackett noticed a dark colored vehicle pulling in behind her. When the pick up truck backed up Tackett began to pull in the spot. Tackett stated the dark colored vehicle whipped around her and pulled in the spot. Tackett stated she believed the dark colored vehicle struck the left front fender of her vehicle.

Tackett took a photo of a dark gray Dodge Challenger Florida Tag with her cell phone and told the driver she was calling the Police. The driver of the Challenger noticed Tackett take a photo and backed up his vehicle and left the area.

I observed a few scratch marks on Tackett's front left fender. No transfer paint was visible on her vehicle. The scratches appeared to be old. I asked Tackett if she was sure the scratches were from today. Tackett told me the scratches could have been old and she just didn't notice them. Tackett stated the main thing she wanted was a report made should the male come back and damage her vehicle.

I located the Dodge parked in the Hull Drive parking lot parked up against a yellow no parking curb. No driver was present. I left a FSUPD business card on the drivers side window.

At approximately 12:15 PM I spoke to Devonta Freeman a current FSU Student who advised yes he had a dispute with another student in regards to a parking spot.

Freeman stated he did drive his vehicle around her but did not hit her vehicle. I ask Freeman if he could just meet me somewhere so I could take a look at his vehicle. Freeman stated he was busy and would call me later.

Freeman called FSUPD but I was unable to speak with him at the time. I attempted to call Freeman two additional times since the 12:20 PM phone call and could not make contact. I could not leave a message for Freeman as his voicemail box has not been set up.

At 3:00 PM I received a call from Monk Bonasorte, Associate Director with Athletics asking if he could bring the vehicle over to FSUPD for me to take a look at due to Freeman being in a mandatory Football meeting. I agreed having already spoken to Freeman via the telephone.

Bonasorte arrived at FSUPD at approximately 3:15 PM I examined the vehicle and did not see any damage on the right front fender.
