	At approximately 9:40 AM, while I was on scene, a white female, Elizabeth Lucido _____), approached the front door of apartment 204. I stopped her and asked her what her intentions were. Lucido informed me she had received a call from her friend and resident of apartment 204, Katherine Vance. Vance requested she (Lucido) go to her apartment (204) and let her dogs out. I informed Lucido apartment 204 was considered a crime scene and nobody was allowed to enter. Lucido acknowledged this information and left the front of the door. She then called Vance and requested that I speak to her. I took Lucido's phone and spoke with Vance, providing the same information about the apartment. Vance told me she was the tenant listed on the lease of the apartment and she questioned me as to what was going on. I informed her I would give an investigator her name and phone number and they would call her back.	
	I then contacted Inv S Bush 672 and gave her this information. Inv Bush took Vance's information and told me she would call her (Vance) when she could answer her questions.

	<p>long. Olenek continued to tell me he started hanging out with Mcallister at approximately 6:00 PM yesterday 07/20/2011. Olenek continued to tell me they left their apartment complex around 11:30 PM and they went to the "strip" (600 block of W Tennessee St) to go to the bars. Olenek explained they (he and Mcallister) hopped from bar to bar (Red Rocks, Kens, and what he refereed to "lower" under Kens) until approximately 1:15 AM to 1:30 AM. They then left the bars and went to the McDonald's restaurant next door to the strip. Olenek told me they got their food "to go" and they left the area and drove home. I asked Olenek what vehicle they drove to the bars in and drove home in and he said "Mcallister's car" and he pointed out a black Chrysler 300 parked on the north side of the #2 apartment building. I asked Olenek if they had anybody with them and he told me "no, it was just the two of us". Olenek then told me they (he and Mcallister) arrived at the apartment complex around 1:58 AM-2:00 AM, 07/21/2011. Mcallister parked his vehicle and they exited. 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Topic Sexual Battery - Supplemental Report

On 07/21/11 at 0410 hours, as the on call SVU Investigator, I was notified by Sgt. Taylor of a sexual battery that occurred at . He advised TPD received the call of a woman banging on doors asking for help because she had been raped. He advised contact was made with the woman, 119.071(2)(h), referred to as V1 for remainder of report. She advised she was picked up at McDonalds by a black male in a black car. She pointed out the car and the apartment, which the black male brought her back too. She advised the male brought her back to his apartment "for a good time" and once she walked in the apartment, he hit her in the back of the head and knocked her to the floor. She said he then forced her to have sex. Sgt. Taylor advised they had knocked on the door of the apartment, but got no answer. He advised he had an officer standing by the apartment until I advised otherwise. He also advised V1 was taken to the TMHER by Ofc. Mordica.

I responded to TMHER and made contact with the V1 briefly. The Exam was about to begin and Ofc. Mordica advised me, Ofc. on scene had determined the occupant of apartment 204 was Demonte McAllister, from information provided by a neighbor. I went back to the station to put together a photo line up. While there, I was notified Officers on scene had made contact with McAllister when he started to leave the apartment. I asked them to transport him to the Police Station for an interview. Once he was at the station, he was placed in interview room number 1. I read him his Miranda Warnings, which he advised he understood and advised he wanted to speak with me. I asked him if he knew why I wanted to talk to him and he advised that it was over the woman who was banging on his door asking for money and a place to stay. He described V1 and advised she had knocked on his door and asked for money and a place to stay. He said he told her, "No", and had to slam the door in her face to get her to go away. He denied ever allowing her in his apartment and denied she was ever in his car. I asked for a consent for buccal swabs and consent for search of his apartment and vehicle, as well as, a swab of his penis. He advised he would consent to the buccal and the search of his apartment and vehicle, but not his penis. I left the room to get the consent forms and swabs, however when I returned he had changed his mind and withdrew consent for all.

I was advised V1 was done with the SAEK and was at the Police Station. I had McAllister moved from room one and placed V1 in the interview room. I attempted an interview with her, which was not very complete because she was coming down from a Cocaine high, as well as, she was under the influence of the medications she had been given at the hospital. During the interview, I had to continually wake her to answer questions. She advised the following account:

She was hanging out at a house on Woodward Ave where several prostitutes hang out. She advised she works as a prostitute. She said a black car, driven by the suspect pulled up and another prostitute known to her as Lettie, was in the passenger seat. Lettie asked her if she knew where Kim was and when she told her no, Lettie suggest she go with the suspect. She said the suspect told her he wanted to have a good time. She said no money was discussed but he said he would "take care of her". She said they went back to his apartment and she said after he unlocked the door, he allowed her to walk in first. Once she was inside he punched her in the head and knocked her to the floor. She did not know if she was knocked out. She advised she had been drinking all day. She said he then grabbed her by the hair and told her, "You are gone suck my dick all night long." He drug her into the bedroom and forced her to perform oral sex on him. She advised he then told her to go into the living room and get on the couch. She said he made her get on her knees with her face in the cushions. She said he penetrated her with his penis in her vagina and her anus, then forced her to perform oral sex on him until he ejaculated in her mouth. She said he then told her to get out but when she went to the door he told her she wasn't going anywhere. She said she ended up on the floor by the door and he was pulling her by the hair again but she eventually got out the door and ran for help. She said she heard him throw her things out the door as she was running off. She said she had lost her phone, her purse, and her false

teeth. She thought she may have lost her teeth in his bed. I attempted to show her a photo line up, however she could not stay awake.

After the interview with V1, I brought McAllister back into room one. I asked him if he recalled his rights and if was willing to continue talking to me. He advised he was. I told him I had spoken with the victim and I knew she was in his car and house. He then said he was scared and told me he had come home that night and went in his apartment. He came back out to his car and was approached by V1 who asked him if he wanted to have sex. He said they got in his car and she gave him a blow job, then climbed on top of him and they had intercourse. He said when they were done she asked for money and a place to stay. He told her he didn't have any money and she could not stay with him. He said she tried to get in his apartment, but he had to close the door on her to keep her from coming in. While interviewing McAllister, Sgt. Revell and Lt. Smith came into the interview room and advised McAllister he had representation in the lobby. At this point he said he wanted to speak with the representative. Atty. Jansen was escorted into the interview room and the recorders were turned off. Atty Jansen advised he had spoken with his client and his client wanted to speak with me again. I went back into the interview room and the recorder was started again. McAllister apologized to me for lying. He advised he had screwed up and was very afraid to tell me the truth because he was ashamed and was afraid of getting in trouble. He then gave the following account:

He went out earlier in the evening with his neighbor, Sean. They returned around 0200 hours and Sean went to Sean's apartment and McAllister decided to go look for a girl. He found one and she gave him oral sex in his car. He said she recommended a girl named Kim so they went looking for her. He said they went to a house where V1 got into his car and went back to his apartment with him. He said once there, she performed oral sex on him in the bedroom, but it wasn't working. She said they went to the living room and he asked her if he could "stick it in her". She said yes and he penetrated her until he was hard again, then she performed oral sex on him until he ejaculated in her mouth. He said when he was penetrating her she made the statement she hoped she was going to get \$50 because she was working like a slave. He said when they were done she wanted money but he did not have any. He said he offered her food, but she did not want any. She asked if she could stay the night with him because she had nowhere to go. He said he told her no and got her out the door. He denied ever hitting her or pulling her hair. He denied forcing her to have sex. He also advised he did not throw her things outside. He said he never even saw her stuff inside. He did recall seeing her purse in the car, because he had picked it up to move it out of the center of the car.

McAllister and his girlfriend Katherine Vance gave consent to search the apartment. A search was conducted. Linens from the bed were taken. A purse with V1's identification, a set of keys and her cell phone were located scattered outside the apartment. (See Forensic Supplement for exact locations).

McAllister was released from our custody and was transported by his attorney. McAllister's keys were utilized to gain entry into the residence and were turned over to his attorney, Tim Jansen. After searching the residence, a walk through of the residence was conducted with the girlfriend, Vance. I explained to her all the items we seized. When we left the apartment, Vance and a neighbor were left at the apartment.

On 07/22/11, V1 called me on the phone requesting to get her items back that we recovered on scene. She asked specifically about her phone, her keys, and her false teeth. I told her we had her keys, phone, and purse, but we did not find her teeth. Originally she advised she lost them in the bedroom, but then she stated, "You didn't find them in the woods?".

The way her items were scattered about the yard and porch, it did not appear someone just threw them out the door. Someone would have had to walk the length of the porch for the items to be everywhere. This was inconsistent with her story about him throwing her stuff from the door after she was outside.

Note: After the search of the residence, later that day, Vance reported a burglary of the apartment.

Tennessee Street when a black male asked her if she wanted to have a good time. 119.071(2)(h) stated she told the suspect yes she wanted to have a good time so she got inside of the vehicle. 119.071(2)(h) said they drove to a house somewhere on Dent Street and purchased some alcohol (Natural Ice Beer). 119.071(2)(h) stated she and the suspect drove back to the incident location. 119.071(2)(h) stated as soon as she walked into the front door of the incident location the suspect hit her so hard in the head that it caused her to fall. 119.071(2)(h) said the suspect then walked into the bedroom and got some petroleum jelly and forced her to have anal sex on the floor in the living room. 119.071(2)(h) stated the suspect made her go into the bedroom where the sexual assault lasted over an hour and a half. 119.071(2)(h) stated the suspect continued to have sex with her in the bedroom. 119.071(2)(h) stated the suspect forced his penis into her mouth and began having oral sex. 119.071(2)(h) stated the suspect then ejaculated into her mouth. 119.071(2)(h) stated the suspect took fifteen dollars from her and told her she was going to walk home.
