On 09/14/10, while on uniformed patrol, I responded to 2630 NW 27th Ter, to assist Ofc. J. Bostick with his investigation of this incident.

Upon arrival, I met with Ofc. Bostick, and Ofc. M. Sides, who had already contacted the Complainant, and her sister/Victim .

I spoke to \_\_\_\_\_ who reported to me that earlier in the evening, she was supposed to have placed a call to her boyfriend Chris, but fell asleep while watching a baseball game with her sister. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that Chris, later identified as Christopher Rainey, became upset, and subsequently responded to the home on his scooter. According to \_\_\_\_\_, Rainey created a disturbance upon his arrival, and threatened to start throwing things through the windows of the house if she didn't exit to talk to him. \_\_\_\_\_ came out of the residence and spoke to Rainey, who continued to yell and curse, and accuse \_\_\_\_\_ of being unfaithful to him. As the encounter continued, \_\_\_\_\_'s sister, who was also outside, informed Rainey that she was going to call the Police. It was then that Rainey left, and that \_\_\_\_\_ began receiving threatening text messages from Rainey.

According to \_\_\_\_\_, this activity is completely out of character for Rainey, who is normally very gentle and laid back. Both \_\_\_\_\_ and her sister advised that Rainey doesn't use drugs or even drink alcohol. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that Rainey, who is a UF football player, has been acting strangely since receiving a head injury in a game played on 09/11/10. \_\_\_\_\_ speculated that Rainey's head injury may be the cause of his actions.

When asked, \_\_\_\_\_ told me that she and Rainey have dated on and off for the past 3 years, and that they were currently in a dating relationship. \_\_\_\_\_, who repeatedly looked exasperated and slightly shaken and confused during my encounter with her, stated that she just couldn't understand what was going on. She went on to state that she was not fearful at all of Rainey, when she exited the house to talk to him. \_\_\_\_\_ stated that she was more shocked that Rainey would overreact so drastically, and wanted to reason with him. \_\_\_\_\_ n stated that upon receiving the text messages from Rainey, her mood changed from shock to fear. I asked \_\_\_\_\_ pointedly, "Are you afraid", to which she responded "Yes, because of the messages he sent me".

Both \_\_\_\_\_ and her sister were informed that due to Rainey's actions, and the fear they created in \_\_\_\_\_, Rainey had committed an act of Aggravated Stalking, which was a felony. When both were informed that we had a duty to act on this incident, \_\_\_\_\_ became reluctant to proceed in reporting the incident. I mistakenly advised \_\_\_\_\_ that due to the fact that her relationship with Rainey was not a Domestic one, she could complete a Complaint Withdrawal, and Rainey would not be arrested. \_\_\_\_\_ took several minutes to decide on this, and mostly deferred the decision to her sister. \_\_\_\_\_ n's sister, who was becoming frustrated with \_\_\_\_\_, told her that the decision was not hers to make because, "it wasn't my boyfriend who came here threatening to kill us all." \_\_\_\_\_ ultimately decided to complete a Complaint Withdrawal after she was told by her sister, "I don't care what you do, but I'm taking my nephew ( \_\_\_\_\_'s 8 year old son) and going to stay at our parent's house." \_\_\_\_\_ stated that she would go with them also, as Rainey would not bother or attempt to contact her at her parent's home.

After researching the Gainesville Police Department General Orders, and Florida State Statutes, I discovered that because Rainey and [redacted]'s relation should was legally defined as a dating relationship, and the act of Aggravated Stalking is a Domestic/Dating Violence incident, [redacted] was informed that a Complainant Withdrawal was not possible, and that Ofc. Bostick was bound by FSS and Department Policy to take a pro-arrest action in incidents of Domestic/Dating Violence.

I next responded to the University of Florida campus with Ofc. Bostick, to make contact with Rainey. After making notification of this incident to UPD Sgt. W. Ledger #028, Ofc. Bostick and I contacted Rainey at his on campus dorm room. When asked if he knew why we were there, Rainey responded, "yeah". I confirmed with Rainey by stating "you had an incident with your girlfriend, right?", to which Rainey replied "it wasn't even like that." I stated to Rainey that he couldn't make threats the way he did, to which he replied, "they knew I didn't mean nothing by that." Rainey was placed in handcuffs, and advised of his Miranda Rights by Ofc. Bostick. Rainey acknowledged and waived his rights, and spoke further to Ofc. Bostick, while I retrieved a pair of shoes for Rainey.

I assisted Ofc. Bostick in escorting Rainey to his patrol vehicle, ending my involvement in this incident.
