On Monday January 13th, 2014 your writers were detailed by Assistant District Attorney Chris Stone to conduct a pre-trial interview of Lt. Jack Kearney (ACSO), who is the head of player security for the Pittsburgh Steelers. This pre-trial meeting took place inside the Criminal Courthouse; Lt. Kearney agreed to relay his actions after being notified that Pittsburgh Steeler Mike Adams was stabbed in the Southside section of the city.

Lt. Kearney went down to UPMC Mercy hospital between 0500 hours and 0600 hours to check on the condition of Adams, after ascertaining an update and checking on his well-being, Lt. Kearney went over to Nakama's restaurant and retrieved Adam's truck keys that were locked up by the valet in their office overnight.

Lt. Kearney moved Adam's Ford F-150 Raptor truck down to the Pittsburgh Steeler Headquarters. While doing this Lt. Kearney remembers observing a "Jimmy-John's" sandwich wrapper and coke located in Adam's truck. Lt. Kearney had nothing else to add concerning this case and was excused from this pre-trial meeting.
