DV Assault 2 counts

On 06/21/14 I met with Officer Ouimet outside the Kirkland Jail sally-port. Officer Ouimet advised me that the arrestee was one Hope Solo. I could hear the arrestee yelling profanities inside the patrol vehicle. I escorted her into the Jail. Officer Ouimet advised me that she was to be booked for DV Assault 4.

I addressed her as Mrs. Solo and was corrected as she informed me her name was now Mrs. Stevens. Mrs. Stevens showed signs of being intoxicated. Her eyes were bloodshot, speech was slurred, lack of good coordination, and the smell of intoxicants coming from her breath were present.

Mrs. Stevens repeatedly insulted myself, and Officer Goguen. Officer Goguen requested that Mrs. Stevens remove her necklace, and Mrs. Stevens stated that the necklace was worth more than he makes in a year. During the fingerprinting of Mrs. Stevens she made numerous statements that I was not worth anything, and should be proud to have such authority.

Hope M Stevens was processed for DV Assault 4 2 counts. Mrs. Stevens was photographed, and fingerprinted. Mrs. Stevens was uncooperative during the processing, and not allowed to provide signatures.

I contacted the attorney she requested Todd Maybrown, Mrs. Stevens was allowed to speak with her attorney for about 15 minutes.

Mrs. Stevens ended the conversation with her attorney. Mrs. Stevens was then placed inside the bathroom by Officer Goguen.

At about 0255hrs myself, and Officer Goguen transported Mrs. Stevens to SCORE jail. Prior to my transport of Mrs. Stevens I placed her in handcuffs behind her back I checked them for proper fit and double locked them for her safety. Mrs. Stevens stated to me that I was scared of her and that was why I placed handcuffs on her. I informed Mrs. Stevens that I did this because I was transporting her to a different jail for housing.

Upon arrival at SCORE Jail we were the third agency in line to have our subjects processed. During the wait Mrs. Stevens began yelling that she needed to use the restroom. I contacted SCORE jail staff who informed me that due to the number of subjects coming in they would not be able to accommodate the request. I attempted to inform Mrs. Stevens of this but all she did was yell over my attempts to explain the situation.

I escorted Mrs. Stevens, and another female inmate to the booking room door. Mrs. Stevens then began to verbally insult myself, and Officer Goguen attempting to incite some reaction. I told Mrs. Stevens to calm down prior to entering the SCORE jail booking room. Once inside SCORE jail Mrs. Stevens began insulting the SCORE jail staff calling one Correction Officer a 14 year old boy, and stated that two officers were having sexual relations. Mrs. Stevens was verbally instructed by SCORE correction officer to walk to their search area. Mrs. Stevens refused to speak with the correction officer verbally instructing her, and then pulled away from the officer. Once this occurred Mrs. Stevens was escorted to a holding cell. Were the officers took Mrs. Stevens to the ground to gain her compliance. Mrs. Stevens was yelling insults at the officer at one point she yelled "you're such a bitch you're scared of me because you know that if the handcuffs were off I'd kick your ass". N/F
